

KEY HIGHLIGHTS – Zambia

This one-pager aims to provide a brief overview of the most salient features of Zambia’s national cooperative landscape, based on the detailed input provided by the cooperative movement.

Currently, Zambia doesn’t have an existing ICA member organization. The data below was gathered through compiling the replies of a secondary cooperative in Zambia to a common questionnaire. For further information, readers are invited to check the methodology in the full report section.

The following figures have been compiled based on the National Savings and Credit Cooperative Union’s data relative to their own member organisations:

Number of cooperatives	1,664
Number of memberships	1,500,000
Number of employees	7,194

In addition, the national statistics total on registered cooperatives as at the close of 2019 are:

- A total of 9,498 registered cooperatives
- The total membership is approximately 1,578,340
- A total of 535 registered women cooperatives
